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

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

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

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

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

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
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Work Sites by Industry Transportation and Warehousing 2012 Quarter 2 – 2016 Quarter 2

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

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
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Work Sites by Industry Finance and Insurance 2012 Quarter 2 – 2016 Quarter 2

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
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Work Sites by Industry Real Estate and Rental and Leasing 2012 Quarter 2 – 2016 Quarter 2

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
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Work Sites by Industry Professional and Technical Services 2012 Quarter 2 – 2016 Quarter 2

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
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Work Sites by Industry Management of Companies and Enterprises 2012 Quarter 2 – 2016 Quarter 2



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
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Work Sites by Industry Administrative and Waste Services 2012 Quarter 2 – 2016 Quarter 2

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
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Work Sites by Industry Educational Services 2012 Quarter 2 – 2016 Quarter 2

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
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Work Sites by Industry Health Care and Social Assistance 2012 Quarter 2 – 2016 Quarter 2

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
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Work Sites by Industry Arts, Entertainment and Recreation 2012 Quarter 2 – 2016 Quarter 2

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
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Work Sites by Industry Accommodation and Food Services 2012 Quarter 2 – 2016 Quarter 2



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

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

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
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Work Sites by Industry State Government 2012 Quarter 2 – 2016 Quarter 2

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



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

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

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

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

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

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

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

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Mining

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Utilities

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Retail Trade

Establishments in these industries use transportation equipment or transportation related facilities as a productive asset. The type of equipment depends on the mode of transportation.
